How Show My Homework can help increase parental engagement

Parental engagement is a key factor to ensure each student is progressing to reach their target grade. Throughout your journey with us your Account Manager will work with you to establish the key goals that your school would like to work towards.

Here are some of our favourite features which have helped our schools see an increase in parental engagement.

Reports & Insights

Senior Leaders and classroom teachers use the User Activity Report which indicates the last login of any user, to see which parents are yet to access their account, and who may need help logging in. They also use our Insights feature that shows which parents haven't viewed homework assignments so that when Parents' Evening comes around, you'll have all the information you need to address any gaps in parental engagement.

Gradebook

Schools who use the Gradebook have noted that this is a key method in increasing parental engagement as they receive notifications when students are given feedback from their teacher. This includes submission status, grade and any comments given by the teacher. These day-by-day updates give parents better clarity regarding how well their child is performing and regular communication from the school about their child's progress.

Parents' Evening workshops

A visit from a Show My Homework trainer during a parents' evening allows them to get logged in on the web and app, understand the Gradebook and see the benefits of their account from Day 1. If you're using the Gradebook, you can print the Parents' Evening report which shows exactly what homework has been assigned, submitted and the grades received.

The Show My Homework app

Parents can download the app from the Play Store or App Store and it only requires them logging in once, after which they will receive regular notifications, straight to their pocket, regarding their child's progress.

Top Tip: We recommend using our Introduction Parent Presentation during a parents' evening or workshop to make sure that all parents login to the app from day 1.
